Israeli army kills three **Palestinians** 

NABLUS, Palestinian Territories: Israeli soldiers shot dead three Palestinian gunmen in a pre-dawn firefight in the occupied West Bank, Israeli and Palestinian sources said Sunday, amid a surge in violence in the region.

The Israeli army said "gunmen opened fire" at an army position near the Jit junction, west of Nablus in the northern West Bank, with the soldiers responding with "live fire". A Nablus-based militant group said ambush for them. The Palestinian health ministry identified three men killed by Israeli gunfire near Nablus as Jihad al-Shami, 24, Udav al-Shami, 22, and Mohammad Dabeek, 18. According to the army, the "three gunmen were neutralised during the exchange of fire and an additional armed gunman surrendered himself to the forces.' It noted in a statement
